Self-Serve is a feature that allows you to quickly make payments and report power outages directly to our outage management system without experiencing busy signals.

Save time and save your phone number as a contact in SmartHub before using Self-Serve. Follow the steps below to do so:

- 1. Download the free SmartHub app in the App Store or Google Play
- 2. Sign in to your SmartHub account
- 3. Select Notifications > Manage Contacts > Add Phone Contact

You can save multiple phone numbers in SmartHub. It will take up to 48 hours for a new phone number to be recognized by our outage management system. Members with multiple Butler Rural Electric Cooperative accounts must enter their account number each time they use Self-Serve.

USING SPACE HEATERS COSTS MORE THAN YOU THINK



Use our space heater calculator to find out how much they add to your bill!

As temperatures drop, you may begin using space heaters. Space heaters can consume a lot of energy when used for long periods of time, even those that claim to be energy efficient. All space heaters are energy hogs. They use roughly 1,500 watts of energy per hour, which adds up to **\$72.90 per month** when used 12 hours a day.

Be especially cautious using space heaters 24/7 in areas with larger heating loads, like an enclosed back porch. You will spend less adjusting your thermostat or by using space heaters to heat small spaces for short periods of time.
